

English

We will be:

- Writing poetry based on the illustrations from our key text.
- Writing reports about polar bears
- Writing a story from the point of view of the character Leaf.
- Continuing to strengthen our phonics and handwriting skills in daily sessions
- We will read every day.

Science

We will be learning to identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are adapted.

Music

We will learn singing within music, including vocal warm ups.
We will learn to perform a song in unison and as a round.
We will learn to accompany songs with simple percussion.
We will listen to and appraise different styles of South African music.

Art

We will be developing our skills in observational drawing, colour mixing, painting and printing based on the book Leaf Man by Lois Ehlert

Geography

We will learn about hot and cold places in the world. Investigate the countries within the Arctic Circle and explore the physical features of the Polar Regions. We will explore Arctic cities and investigate the human features.

Maths

We will be:

- Reviewing place value to 50 before moving on to numbers up to 100.
- Count on and back from different numbers within 100
- Learning more about place value including the meaning of digits in a two-digit number.
- Comparing numbers using language like "more than" "greater than" "less than" and related symbols $<$ $>$ $=$
- Looking at number bonds in relation to place value and calculate within 20.

PE

We will develop gymnastic and dance skills this term.

PSHE

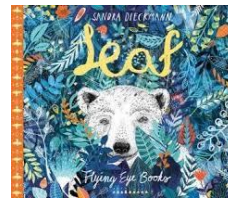
We will be thinking about new beginnings and the return to school.
